Travelling : There are different ways to reach Grenoble :

- by plane : you fly to Lyon St Exupéry airport, and then take a shuttle to Grenoble downtown railway station (20 euros one way, 30 euros round trip ticket) or a rental car (1 hour driving). You can also fly to Geneva, Switzerland and then take a train to Grenoble or a rental car (it takes about 2 hours to drive from Geneva airport to Grenoble)
- by train : you fly to Paris, and then you can take the TGV (high speed train) from Paris Charles de Gaulle airport (3 hours and a half) , or from Paris-Gare de Lyon (3 hours), to Grenoble downtown.
- By car, see the map below.

To reach EFPG from Grenoble downtown : take either a taxi (about 10-15 euros) or the tramway (take the line “Domaine Universitaire”) and exit at the terminus, then there is a 10 minute walk to EFPG, see the map below.
